DEVELOPMENT:

- 1. Starting to smile in response to you.
- 2. Starting to coo in response to your voice.
- 3. Startles (though inconsistently) to loud noises.

ACCIDENT PREVENTION:

- 1. *Always* use a car seat. Use a rear facing seat until baby weighs 20 pounds and is one year of age.
- 2. Some babies start rolling over—be careful!
- 3. Avoid necklaces or long cords used to attach toys or pacifiers to crib or baby.
- 4. Use smoke alarms.
- 5. Set water heater for less than 120°F.
- 6. Take an infant CPR course.
- 7. Avoid microwaving formula bottles—test all heated formula *carefully* before feeding the baby.

ILLNESS:

- 1. Acetaminophen drops (*not* Syrup or Elixir) 0.4 mL every 3-4 hours for babies 6-11 pounds, and 0.8 mL every 3-4 hours for babies 12-17 pounds.
- 2. Acetaminophen sold as Tempra, Tylenol, Panadol, Liquiprin, etc.

NEXT VISIT:

At four months of age.
